

Hello folks,

The TAWN elections for 2010 are now open. Please direct any questions, in private, to any of the current TAWN Board Members.

Nominations can to be made, and have been accepted by the nominee, between now and close of TAWN's Monthly business meeting in August. (August 14, 2010). Nominations and acceptances are to be made off list.

The slate of Nominees will be officially announced after the TAWN August Monthly business meeting.

Before nominating anyone, be sure that the person you are nominating is willing to accept and fulfill the nomination requirements.

Nominee requirements:

1. Be a member in good standing.
2. a. Have not been on the Board for all the last 4 consecutive years.
b. Will not exceed the 4 year limit during the term they are nominated to serve for.

Nominee requirements for Coordinator and Vice Coordinator:

Must fulfill the nominee requirements of 1 &2 listed above.

3. Have served on the TAWN Board, in any capacity, for one full year in the past 4 years.

By accepting a nomination a nominee is declaring that they have read and understood that their responsibilities and duties as officers of TAWN are specified by the Arizona Revised Statutes governing 501(c)3 organizations. A statement to this effect will be present on the ballot forms.

Nominees may obtain information about the Arizona Revised Statutes from the TAWN coordinator.

The six positions open for this year's elections are:

Coordinator (Two Year Term)(Incumbent: Raymond Offord)
Secretary (Two Year Term)(Incumbent Raya Fand)
Member at Large (Two Year Term)(currently vacant)

Vice-Coordinator (One Year Term)(currently vacant)
Member at Large (One Year Term)(currently vacant)
Member at Large (One Year Term)(currently vacant)
